I Common Collapse-Speak Swears & Expletives

skrell – General frustration / equivalent to “damn”
“Skrell this feedback loop...”

glitchborn – Insult; someone flawed, unstable, or untrustworthy
“That glitchborn scav nearly got me fried.”

staticrot – Used to label lies, corruption, or mental decay
“Everything outta that camp is staticrot.”

driftfused – Mentally scrambled, confused, or emotionally broken
“You sound driftfused. Pull it together.”

freqdamned – Strong oath; condemned by signal itself
“This freqdamned node is cursed.”

jam-core – Total breakdown or chaos; hardware/software meltdown
“The whole relay went jam-core before I even touched it.”

nullspawn – Deep insult; implies a person is empty or born of void
“You deal with nullspawn, you get ghosted.”

coil-slag – Worthless; ruined beyond repair
“That’s just coil-slag. Toss it.”

tone-wreck – Burnout; emotional collapse or fried logic
“He’s a full tone-wreck after that gate surge.”

I Exclamations & Phrases

“Disson!” – A guttural expletive / expression of shock or frustration
“Disson! That nearly breached the vault.”

“Fract it.” – Soft curse; equivalent to “screw it” or “forget it”
“Fract it. We go dark till sunrise.”

“By the Ninth.” – Oath referencing PLAN-9 initiative / mythic importance
“By the Ninth, you’re serious.”

“Dead link.” – Metaphor for betrayal, emotional cutoff, or trust severed
“After what you did...we’re a dead link now.”
