Current Status: Fragmented / Partially Active / Doctrinally Split
Primary Function: Harmonic study, signal stabilization, resonance governance
Common Alias: The Guild
Post-Collapse Offshoot: Signal Harmonics Guard (see restricted addendum)

ORIGIN

The Signal Harmonics Guild predates the Collapse by generations.

It was founded when early signal theorists discovered that sound was not merely vibration, but a structural force—capable of influencing memory, matter, cognition, and spacetime coherence.

Where others heard noise, the Guild heard architecture.

They believed the world was tuned, not built.

CORE DOCTRINE

The Guild operated under three immutable principles, known as The Harmonic Laws:

All systems resonate.
Nothing exists in silence—only in balance or dissonance.

Unbounded signal invites collapse.
Harmonics without discipline corrupt both mind and environment.

STRUCTURE & PRACTICE

Tonal Engineers – Designers of stabilizers, resonators, and sound engines

Archivists – Keepers of Codices, forbidden frequencies, and lost tones

Harmonic Theorists – Philosophers of resonance and reality

Wardens – Rare operatives tasked with field containment (see disputed doctrine)

Initiation required attunement trials—many failed.
Some never returned.

TECHNOLOGICAL LEGACY

The Guild was responsible for the creation or early study of:

Neurophonic Interfaces

Resonant Architecture

Signal Vaults

Early Auralith Constructs (origin classification: REDACTED)

Gate Phenomena later termed Neurophonic Gates

Much of this technology was lost, sealed, or deliberately erased prior to the Collapse.

⚠ THE SCHISM

As harmonic instability spread, a faction within the Guild argued that knowledge was no longer enough.

They advocated:

Preemptive signal suppression

Forced containment

Harmonic interdiction

The Guild fractured.

From its enforcement wing rose a hardened doctrine—order over understanding.
